Highlights

GM Wintergarden

Groups arrive at the GM Wintergarden, one of Detroit's focal points. This magnificent five story tropical glass atrium overlooks the Detroit River and is always bustling with activity.

GM Plaza and Promenade

The GM Renaissance Center's outdoor plaza features a world map carved in granite, synchronized water fountain and an amazing view of the Detroit River.

GM Lobby and Pavilion

The GM Pavilion is an impressive and inviting glass and steel entrance featuring vehicle displays.

"Borealis" Art Glass Structure

Located in the front lobby of the GM Renaissance Center, Borealis is the tallest vertical glass structure in the world!

Circulation Ring

Suspended from stainless steel cables, this architecturally impressive circular glass walkway provides easy navigation and connects visitors to additional shops and restaurants in the Millender Center, along with easy access to the People Mover Station.

GM Showroom

This popular 44,000 square-foot attraction offers an exciting, interactive look at GM's Buick, Chevrolet, Cadillac and GMC brands. Ever changing displays include GM production models, vintage and concept vehicles and large screen video displays highlighting GM's initiatives, products and services. Check out the interactive kiosks and a special OnStar display that features a 'turn by turn' demonstration within a vehicle. 
Ren Cen Shops

DIRECTIONS TO THE GM RENAISSANCE CENTER

From Pontiac, Rochester and the North:

I-75 Southbound to I-375, to Jefferson Avenue Westbound

From Clinton Township, St. Clair Shores and the East:

I-94 Westbound to I-75 South, to I-375, to Jefferson Avenue Westbound

From Ann Arbor, Metro Airport and the West:

I-94 Eastbound to I-75 South, to I-375 to Jefferson Avenue Westbound

From Canada:

Via the Detroit-Windsor Tunnel, turn right at Jefferson Avenue. Via the Ambassador Bridge, take I-75 North to I-375, to Jefferson Avenue Westbound
