The first observance of Labor Day is believed to have been in New York City in 1882 organized by Peter McGuire, a carpenters and joiners union secretary. In 1883, a union resolution declared the first Monday in September as Labor Day and in 1894, Congress signed a bill to establish it a federal holiday.
