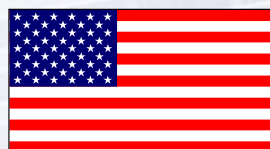

In 1883, a union resolution declared the first Monday in September as Labor Day and in 1894, Congress signed a bill to establish it a federal holiday.*
