## 300 EAST RANDOLPH GARAGE BICYCLE PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Garage Bicycle Parking spaces are limited for use by current building employees only and will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. If demand exceeds availability, a waiting list will be created in the event space becomes available in the future. Registration with the CBRE Building Management Office is required to secure a Garage Bicycle Parking Space or to be put on a waiting list.
- 2. Licensees must ride on a regular basis. Access to the parking garage and the Bicycle Parking Release and Waiver will be terminated after 30 calendar days of non-use. Bicycles abandoned after 30 days will be removed by the Building.
- Garage Bicycle Parking access is via mid-level Randolph Street, 300 East Randolph Garage ONLY. Bicycles are NOT to be transported through the building lobby, freight elevator or parking garage elevator.
- Garage Bicycle Parking access rights will be added to your existing building access card. Access for Garage Bicycle Parking does NOT allow access for automobile parking in the garage.
- 5. Garage Bicycle Parking Hours will mirror your assigned Building access hours.
  Tenant access: 24/7. HCSC employee access: assigned building access based on your current employee status/position.
- 6. Bikes must be locked/secured to the bike racks using your own lock.
- 7. Garage Bicycle Parking access rights are not transferrable or to be shared. "Piggy-backing" is not allowed and will result in the termination of Garage Bicycle Parking access rights.
- 8. Building identification stickers must be visible on the bike at all times, in the event ownership needs to be verified.
