Menu items are simple, not too complex; all farm to table fresh ingredients, and most menu items are under \$20.

Untitled 111 (111 West Kinzie) a lavish new 'speakeasy' in River North carries the largest amount of American whiskey in the world. This part restaurant, part lounge and part nightclub-boasts 17,000 square feet with soaring ceilings, leather walls, velvet booths and a wall of wooden liquor lockers that not only hold the many whiskey selections but those VIP member's unfinished bottles of the good stuff. They also offer live entertainment 5 nights a week sampling various genres including jazz, western, swing, blues, soul and more. The menu features a raw bar, snacks, small and large plates developed by Chef Joseph Heppe formerly of Mercat a la Planxa.
