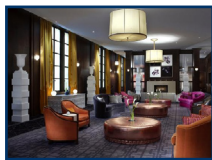
To Open

Foodseum (109 North Dearborn) The city's first food-centric museum will display its first full exhibit on the second floor of the Block 37 shopping mall starting September 19th and running through December 20. Foodseum founder and executive director Kyle Joseph is calling the debut exhibit a teaser for when he and his staff eventually find a permanent home. The debut exhibit will be "The Hot Dog and Encased Meats of the World." Visitors will be able to smell the spices that go into 23 different sausages, as the Foodseum promotes interactivity. They'll even offer food samples during a few select weekends. Admission is free, and they'll be open from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m., Wednesday through Sunday.

Method Greenhouse (East 111th) built by the New York-based company Gotham Greens, it will use 20 times less land and 10 times less water than a standard agricultural system with the same output. Once fully operational, the greenhouse will grow over 1 million pounds of pesticide-free greens, including kale, arugula, bok choy and butterhead lettuce annually. Gotham Greens will distribute the produce to local stores, farmer's markets and restaurants. The greenhouse is just the latest of Method's many environmentally-friendly innovations. The "ecological factory" is outfitted with three solar "trees," which move to follow the sun, and a 230 ft. tall wind turbine. Collectively, on-site renewable energy sources supply the factory with one-third of all its power.

Travel Abroad: Comfort Food

The weather is cooling off and its time to warm up from the inside. Travel across the globe during your winter months and try these great dishes or make them at home!

Arroz Abanda



Ingredients:

1/2 pound shelled fava beans
3 ounces pancetta or bacon
1 small onion, minced
1 large handful cherry tomatoes,
1/2 pound Swiss chard
2 tablespoons olive oil

Directions:

1. In a large pot of salted water, boil the fava beans for 2-3 minutes and drain.
2. In a large, heavy-bottomed pan, brown the onions in the olive oil over medium heat.
3. Add the bacon, fry for a few minutes, then add the fava beans and Swiss chard.
4. Toss to combine and let it cook at low temperature with the lid on for 10-15 minutes.
5. Add the chopped tomatoes and cook for another 10 minutes, adding hot water if it becomes too dry.
6. Add salt and pepper to your liking and serve immediately.

Spicy Moroccan Shrimp Tagine



Ingredients:

2 tablespoons olive oil
4 medium ripe tomatoes, halved, seeded and grated
6 cloves garlic, minced
2 tablespoons flat-leaf parsley
2 tablespoons fresh cilantro
1 teaspoon sweet paprika

1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
1/4 teaspoon ground cumin
1 bay leaf
1 1/2 pounds large shrimp, peeled, tails left on
3 slices lemon, halved

Directions:

1. In a tagine, flameproof casserole, or heavy skillet or saute pan, add the olive oil, tomatoes, and garlic, and cook uncovered over medium heat until the tomatoes are a deeper red and pulpy, about 12 minutes.
2. Reduce the heat to low. Stir in the parsley, cilantro, paprika, cayenne and cumin.
3. Add the bay leaf and season with salt and pepper. Place the shrimp on top and cook for 1 minute, and then turn.
4. Place the lemon slices around the edges of the tagine, dribble 2 tablespoons water in the side, cover, and cook for 10 minutes.
5. Serve bubbling hot in the tagine.
